INSTALL / DISPLAY INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Pound the 7" spike into the ground using a hammer or mallet (face the pointed end into ground).
- 2. Insert the 36" stems into the spike (if greater height is desired, acquire a 3 ft. to 10 ft. by 1/4" diameter copper pipe).
- 3. Slide the ring up or down to achieve the look and sound desired (up for less or no chime, down for more chime).
- **4.** Bend the copper leaves away from the stems (so the chimes function properly). The ends are sharp, be sure to use caution when handling the leaves.
- **5**. To keep the copper chimes looking new, spray a clear enamel finish (available at local hardware stores), or let them patina naturally outdoors. The chimes can be left outside year round, regardless of the weather.
- *Note: if installing in a pot 1. use a scrap piece of 2x4, 2. drill 1/4 hole into the wood, 3. pound spike into hole,
- 4. bury into the soil, this will act as an anchor, 5. pack the soil tight inside pot.

Ways to display your one of a kind handcrafted copper chimes: install in flower pots, koi pond, logs/driftwood, flower beds, desertscape, water elements, etc. If yard space is limited, these would look beautiful on a balcony, deck or patio.
